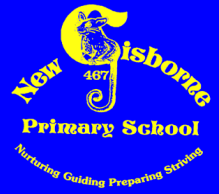

Dear Parents and Guardians

Head Lice

It has come to our attention that some students in the school have head lice so I am seeking your cooperation in checking your child's hair this week.

Head lice do not transmit infectious diseases – they are transmitted by having head to head contact with someone who has head lice. You may be reassured to know that head lice are commonly found in places other than at school. Head lice are common in school-aged children and are the most adaptable of creatures. They have survived living solely on humans for 10,000 years!!!!

What can you do?

When checking your child's hair and in those instances where head lice or eggs are found, treating your child's hair is important. Treatments are really only effective against the lice not the eggs so you will need to treat and comb your child's hair more than once to break the cycle.

Dear Resident.

We are pleased to inform you that Prendergast Earthmoving has been appointed to undertake a project in your area. The scheduled work will include Major Road reconstruction, which will also include upgrades to drainage, Sewer and Water assets.

The project is set to commence on the 4th of August, weather permitting, and is expected to be completed by the 31st of October. Due to the limitations, this project will require a Road closure throughout construction. Alternative routes will be necessary; we will have a detour during this time, which will direct traffic via Hamilton Road.

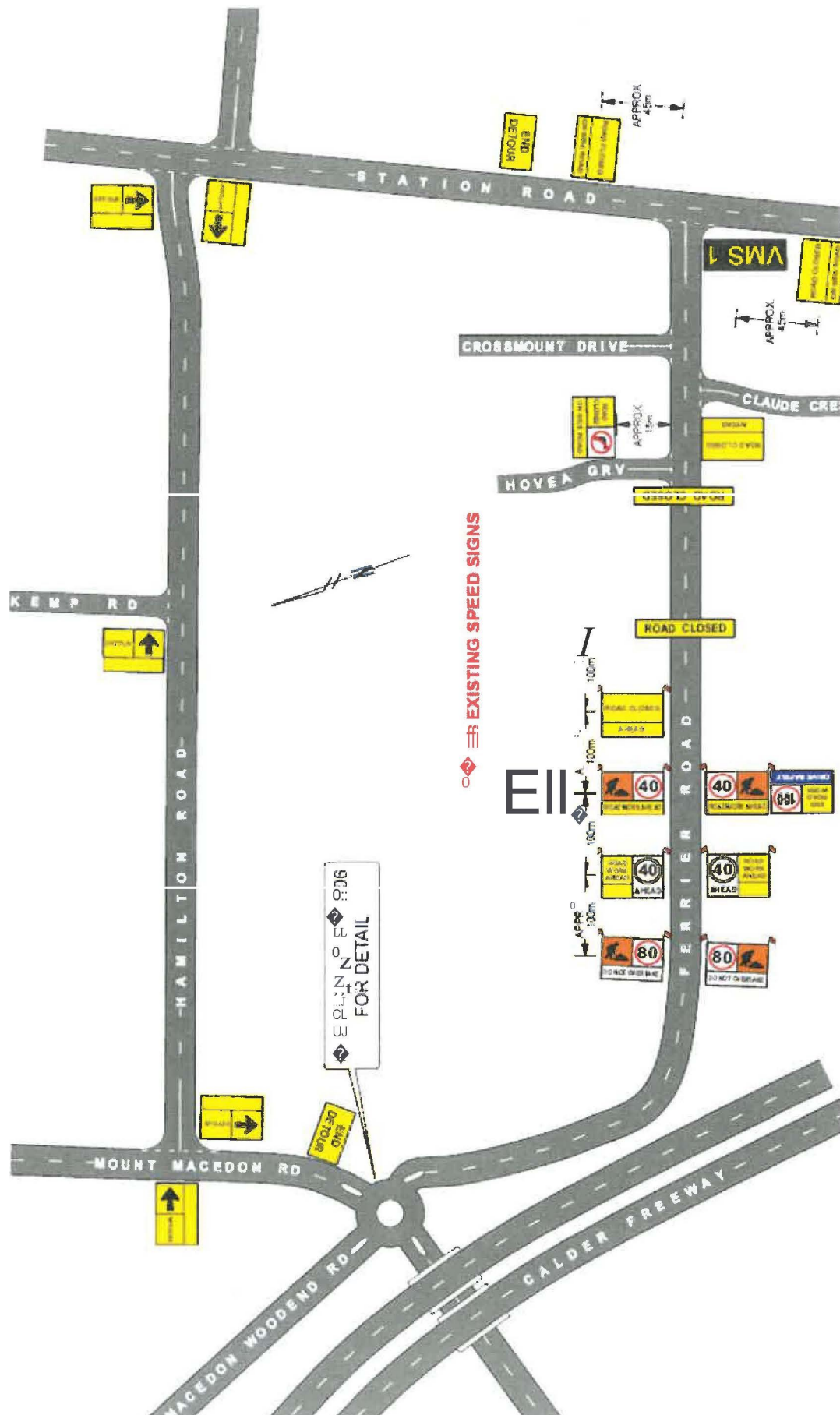

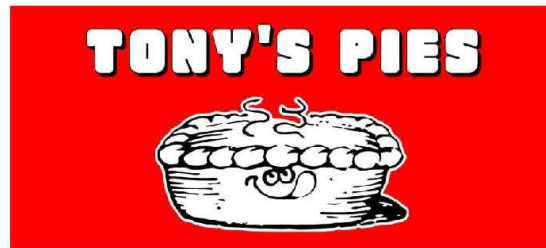

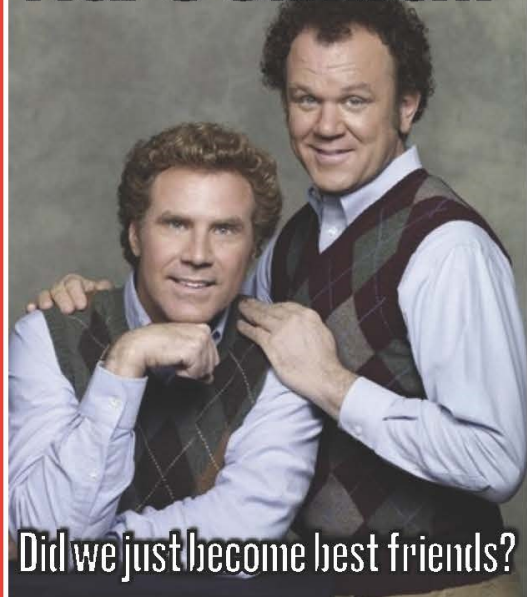
