NAPLAN Results

Parents of students in Year 3 and Year 5 will receive their child's NAPLAN Individual Student Report this week. The assessments, conducted in March, covered Numeracy, Reading, Writing, and Conventions of Language (Spelling, Grammar, and Punctuation).

We are extremely proud of all of our students and the hard work that they put into these one off tests. Thank you to all the staff who helped facilitate this and keep it as stress free as possible for our students. We had a very high participation rate this year with 100% of students completing most tests, which is amazing considering the amount of illness we had at that time. Our Year 3 reading data is amongst the highest in the state and significantly above similar schools and the state average.







This year, NGPS will be fielding two Human Powered Vehicle (HPV) teams at the upcoming Energy Breakthrough event.


With guidance and support from adults, students are challenged to design and build an HPV, race it across three events, and create a display and presentation to present to a panel of judges.


