Dear Parents and Students,

We have entered a team to participate in this year's Energy Breakthrough competition held in Maryborough from Wednesday 22nd – Sunday 26th of November 2023.

Briefly

The Energy Breakthrough Challenge is a three-day event held in Maryborough in November each year. Each team comprises eight team members of 4 girls and 4 boys.

New Gisborne will participate in the Tryathlon event in 2022. Students will maintain and race a recumbent tricycle throughout an obstacle course, sprint race and 8 hour endurance event. Students are also required to present their learning to a panel of judges in a 10 minute presentation.



Teams will meet during school lunchtime to train and rehearse their play. Interested parents and students are invited to an information evening on Tuesday 16th May from 6.00pm - 6.45pm in the classroom behind the Indonesian room.
